
## THE COURSE

## **BROOKS GOLF CLUB POLICIES**

### 1. **Deposit**

A deposit of \$500.00 is required prior to the date of the event, which will be used toward the invoice total. A meeting will be arranged with the tournament manager and/or food and beverage manager 30 days prior to set up meals and number of players, 10 days prior to confirm. Cancellations must be made at least 60 days in advance to recover deposit. Cancellations after 60 day deadline forfeit deposit. Tournaments may be booked less than 60 days in advance; however, deposit will be forfeited if event is cancelled.

### 2. **Liquor Regulation**

**Absolutely no liquor or ice chests will be brought on to the golf course property.** Golfers who bring outside alcoholic beverages onto the golf course property will be removed, without refund from the event and will be escorted off the property immediately. For the enjoyment of your guests, please ensure that they are aware of this policy before they arrive.

### 3. **Drink Holes and Corporate Sponsorship**

Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission regulations states:

5.15.1 Patrons are not allowed to bring liquor onto a golf course. All liquor sold and consumed on a golf course must be sold and served by the licensee and dispensed by the licensee.

5.15.3 During a tournament a licensee may sell and serve liquor at temporary locations, in addition to kiosks specified in section 5.15.2c, provided the service is limited to one location on the front nine and one location on the back nine holes.

5.15.5 Liquor promotions involving liquor suppliers, liquor agencies or their registered representatives are restricted as follows:

- A) No liquor may be sold or served on a golf course by a liquor suppliers, liquor agencies or their registered representatives .
- B) Liquor for tasting must be purchased from the licensee; it cannot be brought onto the golf course by a liquor suppliers, liquor agencies or their registered representatives.
- C) Liquor for tasting may be served on by the licensee staff; how ever a registered representative may be present to describe the merits of the product to the patrons

### 4. **Food Sponsors**

Any food not purchased through The Brooks Golf Club will be charged \$2.50/person

### 5. **Responsible Beverage Service**

We at Brooks Golf Club are committed to the safety of all our guest. We encourage alternate transportation to be arranged by the coordinator for all hosted functions. Drinking and driving is a serious matter and we all want to make sure that our guests arrive home safely. Brooks Golf Club staff is always available to help you arrange transportation.

### 6. **Dress Code**

Blue jeans and t-shirts are permitted if they are clean and do not contain offensive language or material. No metal spikes, tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, short gym shorts, or cut offs will be accepted on the premises. Shirts must be worn at all times.

### 7. **Power Cart Usage**

In the event a power cart is damaged by a participant, the tournament will assume responsibility for the repair of the cart. By signing the tournament contract, the organizers agrees to hold Brooks Golf Club and it's employees free of any liability or claims for the use thereof.

### 8. **Weather Cancellations/ Rescheduling**

Tournaments will be deemed playable unless course management closes the course. In the event of closure the golfing portion of the tournament will be rescheduled. If this is not possible, our rain check policy will apply to all participants. The banquet portion will be held regardless of weather. Cold weather, rain and wind are not deemed reasons to cancel.

### 9. **Signage /Course Materials**

All signage and course material must be approved by the Brooks Golf Club and must be placed on course by Golf Club employees.

- Any damages incurred to the Brooks Golf Club, its equipment, or its facilities, that was inflicted directly by the participants of this event will become the ultimate responsibility of the event. Any costs incurred to repair such damages will be billed directly to the event.
